<b>EMCC Awareness Training (7032)</b>			
<b>Training Objectives</b>	<p>At the end of this session learners should be aware of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The safety requirements of the EMCC</li> <li>• Signage for the EMCC</li> <li>• Planning required for the EMCC</li> <li>• The operational procedures and uses of the EMCC</li> <li>• Dealing with incidents and incursions</li> <li>• The assessment process to become a qualified EMCC operator.</li> </ul>		
<b>Target audience</b>	<p>All persons needing to be aware of the Enhanced Mobile Carriageway Closure techniques and this course a pre-requisite for EMCC Operator practical assessments.</p> <p>On completion of the EMCC Awareness Training successful Learners will be issued with an awareness only e-certificate which is valid for 2 years. Once this expired there is no 'grace' period.</p> <p>Learners who have completed the awareness only training will have two years to get assessed from the date of the training.</p>

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<b>EMCC Operator Assessments (7105)</b>	
<b>Target audience</b>	All persons required to carry out Enhanced Mobile Carriageway Closure techniques
<b>Pre-requisites</b>	<p>EMCC Operators – must hold a valid EMCC Awareness training course and be a current 12AB General Operative Skilled Worker.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is recommended that the EMCC Operator will have gained a at least 6 months experience of regular participation in Static TTM on dual carriageways and motorways.</li> <li>• It is important that they can understand verbal communications from the appointed LTMO or Foreman, relating to the execution of EMCC.</li> </ul>
<b>EMCC Operator Assessment</b>	<p>Learners can obtain full EMCC Operator status by completing the EMCC Awareness training course and successfully achieve the EMCC Operator assessment.</p> <p>You will be required to complete a minimum of 1 live assessment consisting of 3 units. Once you have started the assessment process you have 2 years to complete the assessment.</p> <p>The EMCC Operator skilled worker e-card is valid for 5 years.</p> <p>You must hold a valid 12AB Operative skilled worker card before undertaking any EMCC assessments and hold throughout the lifespan of the EMCC skill.</p> <p><b>On site assessments:</b> 1:1 (Assessor:Learner)</p> <p><u>Learner Requirements</u></p> <p>EMCC Assessors and Training Providers need to ensure any learner undertaking an EMCC assessment have the required prerequisites to do so. Learners as a minimum need to hold:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An in date and valid NHSS 12A/B Operative Skilled Worker category.</li> <li>2. An in date and valid EMCC Awareness Certificate.</li> </ol> <p>If the learner does not have these requirements, then their EMCC Operator assessment should not proceed or be completed until the prescribed prerequisites are met.</p> <p>Each learner must be assessed individually whilst undertaking EMCC operations; The EMCC Assessor must be an approved to carry out assessment. They will not be part of the EMCC operation. Learners must be assessed on a one-to-one basis.</p>
<b>Duration/timing</b>	<b>EMCC Operator Assessments – 1 live assessment covering 3 units</b>
<b>Ratios</b>	EMCC Operator Assessment: 1:1 Assessor:Learner

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<p><b>Facilities and equipment</b></p>	<p>It is the specific responsibility of the training provider to ensure risk assessments have been carried out on training location(s) and the following items are available.</p> <p>The training provider is responsible for advising the learners of the equipment/vehicles they must have available on practical assessment.</p> <hr/> <p><b>Training provider</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Projector and screen/suitable projection surface/laptop compatible media device e.g. digital whiteboard</li> <li>• Lap top computer with media software capable of running the PowerPoint Presentation</li> <li>• Notepaper, Pencils, Pens, Erasers</li> <li>• White board / Flip Chart</li> <li>• Recommended road layout and model vehicles</li> <li>• Registration Pad and Attendance Sheet</li> <li>• Question papers</li> <li>• Allowed Reference Materials</li> <li>• Instructor must be Lantra approved to deliver EMCC Awareness training and registered to the Provider</li> <li>• Assessor must be Lantra approved to carry out EMCC Operator Assessments and registered to the Provider with a compliant vehicle for EMCC</li> <li>• Mobile Phone excluded from classroom environment poster.</li> </ul>
