Qualification

Delivery Method: Practical observation and assessment

Prerequisites: Entry for these qualifications is available to any individual who is capable of achieving the required standard. Provider staff should understand the demands of these qualifications and match learners based on their individual capabilities and future progression requirements.

Before registering on this qualification you must have achieved the following:

Chainsaw Maintenance.

Cross-cut timber using a chainsaw.

Introduction

Show that you can maintain your chainsaw to industry standard with this Nationally recognised assessment.

These qualifications are requirements for Professional Users to operate chainsaws in the UK.

Overview in brief

Chainsaws need to be constantly maintained to work in a safe and efficient manner.

This assessment is nationally recognised and is the first step towards becoming a fully qualified chainsaw user.

For professional chainsaw operators working in forestry and arboriculture the industry



recommendation is that for 'high risk' activities the minimum level of adequacy of training is to a certificate of competence or nationally recognised qualification where assessment is carried out independently of the training. **This qualification meets this requirement'**

This course will enable you to prove your expertise in a vital area of forestry and arboricultural work.

It will also provide firm evidence of your ability to meet licence-to-practise standards.
