Qualification

Delivery Method: Theory/practical

Prerequisites: Entry for these qualifications is available to any individual who is capable of achieving the required standard. Provider staff should understand the demands of these qualifications and match learners based on their individual capabilities and future progression requirements.

Before registering on this qualification you must have achieved the following:

Award in Felling and Processing Trees over 380mm and have a thorough understanding of felling techniques.

These qualifications are requirements for Professional Users to operate chainsaws in the UK.

Overview in brief

Assisted felling is an essential skill for many people working in the forestry and arboricultural sectors.

Our course will help you build on the skills and experience you already possess.

It will give you the chance to obtain a competency card to open up job opportunities in your chosen sector.

For professional chainsaw operators working in forestry and arboriculture the industry recommendation is that for 'high



risk' activities the minimum level of adequacy of training is to a certificate of competence or nationally recognised qualification where assessment is carried out independently of the training. **This qualification meets this requirement'**

This course will enable you to prove your expertise in a highly skilled area of forestry and arboricultural work.

It will also provide firm evidence of your ability to meet licence-to-practise standards.
