### The finer details

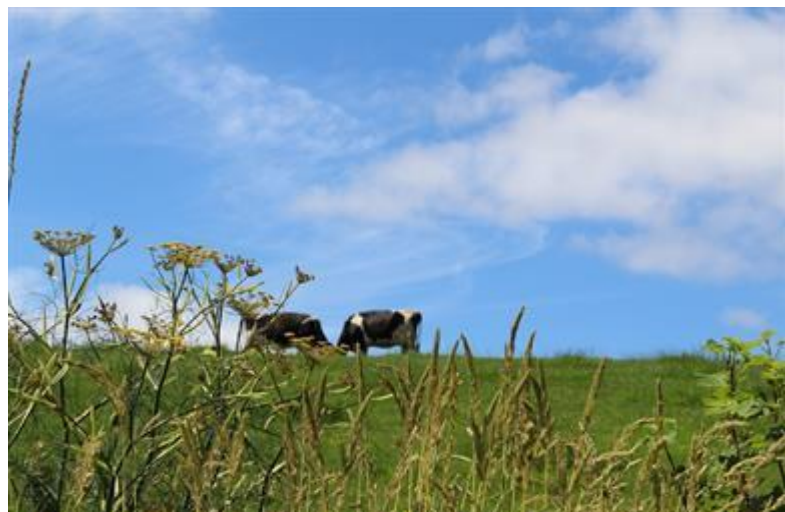
This course consists of four modules. A minimum score of 70% is required to pass it.
