Introduction

This level one rifle course is available to you if you have little or no previous knowledge or experience.

Overview in brief

Designed to provide a mixture of both classroom and practical training, learners can quickly learn the skills, knowledge and understanding required to safely handle a rifle.

Who should attend?

This course has been designed for those that regularly use a rifle as part of their daily job such as; estate managers, farm owners, shooting syndicates, game keepers, and those who either employ gamekeepers or allow contractors onto their land to shoot.

Learners who require a refresher course, beginners, and novice shooters who would like to hold a recognised qualification are very to complete this course.
