Introduction

The course will enable candidates to develop skills needed to use a dumper within the cemetery and churchyard.

Students will learn to use a dumper, within the confines of a cemetery / church yard.

Candidates will be shown & demonstrated the use of a dumper procedure. Then be asked to prove competency through a practical / theory assessment.

Any person working within the bereavement industry in or around cemeteries or church yards. May that be full time or personnel used for cemetery cover.
