The finer details

This qualification has been developed to enhance and assess your skills and knowledge in monitoring excavation in the highway. This qualification forms part of our suite of Street Works Initial certificates.

Training can be provided before assessment, but is not compulsory. The assessment will consist of a question paper and practical assessment. Assessment will cover:

- Location and avoidance of underground apparatus
- Monitoring signing, lighting and guarding
- Monitoring excavation in the highway.

If successful in meeting the required standards assessed, you will be awarded the corresponding qualification (non-regulated) certificates in:



- Street Works Initial Location and avoidance of underground apparatus
- Street Works Initial Monitoring signing, lighting and guarding
- Street Works Initial Monitoring excavation in the highway.



You will also be able to register on the Street Works Qualification Register (SWQR), which is required under the New Roads and Street Works Act.

Who should attend?

This certificate is for anyone aged 16+ who is employed in carrying out works in the highway.

Upon successful completion, you'll be awarded a qualification (non-regulated) certificate in:

Street Works Initial - Signing, lighting and guarding.

What will be covered?

At the end of this qualification, your practical skills, knowledge and understanding will have been assessed on:

- Location and avoidance of underground apparatus
- Monitoring signing, lighting and guarding
- Monitoring excavation in the highway.
