Worth noting: First aid at work certificates are valid for three years and a two-day qualification course must be carried out within one month of expiry. Don't leave it any longer or you'll have to take a full first aid at work course.

Who should attend?

This course is ideal for you if you work in any industry and need to ensure that you have the relevant training to carry out first aid. It is suited to those working in high-risk working environments, such as building sites, warehouses etc.

What will be covered?

The basics needed to provide first aid in the workplace for minor incidents or until medical professionals arrive.

- Understand the role and responsibilities of a first aider
- Assess an incident
- Provide first aid to an unresponsive casualty
- Provide first aid to a casualty with external bleeding
- Provide first aid to a casualty who is in shock
- Manage a casualty with minor injuries.
