Prerequisites: All participants on the course must have prior working experience within the veterinary or canine rehabilitation or canine conditioning sector and/or be a member of one of the animal therapy professional bodies RAMP, ACPAT, IAAT, IRVAP, AHCP. This experience will be checked on application to the course.

Introduction

The first ever certified canine kinesiology taping certificate. This course enables therapists to become skilled in the application of kinesiology taping to treat a wide variety of common musculoskeletal conditions in the canine patient.

The finer details

There are 2 routes of completion for this course:

- Online remote learning solely
- Onsite/classroom based in person learning

Each route has the same content and practical elements and assessments.
