Introduction

On this one day assessment, you will demonstrate knowledge of all aspects of Cornish Hedge construction by building 1m of hedge within the set time. Learners must have already achieved an Intermediate Certificate in Cornish Hedging and evidenced 40 additional days of further work/practice.

The finer details

The Advanced Certificate in Cornish Hedging is the consolidation of all prior training with CREST. During the assessment, you will have to build a linear metre of Cornish Hedge; this will evidence a demonstration of all Cornish Hedge construction methods, as well as setting the foundations for being able to move into the working world, with this being a tested place for you to individually base pricing work upon.

Who should attend?

Suitable for those looking to embark on a career as a Cornish Hedger.

You must already have gained an Intermediate Certificate in Cornish Hedging and evidenced an additional 40 days of work/practice.

What will be covered?

- The assessment is entirely practical. You will have the course of the session to build all elements of 1m of Cornish Hedge.
- The finished piece will be assessed on each individual element constructed, as well as an overall piece.
