This is the assessment to enable a cattle foot trimmer to obtain the Assessment in Cattle Foot Trimming.

The assessment is recognised by the NACFT, Map of Ag and all relevant bodies to be of a high standard.

The finer details

The assessment allows the trimmer to be registered with the NACFT and accredited as external trimers with Map of Agri, Milk Buyers and Farm Assurance.

The Assessment has 2 parts:

THEORY: Candidates complete Multiple Choice Questions on cattle foot trimming and hoof care.PRACTICAL: Candidates have their trimming skills assessed whilst they trim live cows. Their skill and outcome are evaluated.

Who should attend?

The assessment is for those wishing to undertake all on farm trimming and be recognised by relevant bodies, NACFT, Map of Agri, Milk Buyers and Farm Assurance. Trimmers who have undergone the foundational training of the Professional Foot Trimming course and CPD Check days.
